

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Saturday 21 Jul 2012

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Northern Ireland and western Scotland starting fine but clouding over steadily with light rain arriving later. Elsewhere generally much drier and sunnier than of late. Feeling warm with very little wind. Overnight rain and wind spreading across Scotland and into northern England, with Northern Ireland tending to become dry. The rest of the UK staying dry and mostly clear.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
Cloud and rain sinking slowly southwards through Sunday and Monday, progressively affecting Wales, Northern Ireland and a greater area of northern England. Remaining dry, sunny and becoming very warm in southeastern and central parts. Sunshine rather hazy in the southwest.
