Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Rain in southeast England will clear to leave most places dry and sunny after a cold start in the north with patchy fog. Showers on some coasts, especially in the east with a chilly breeze. Quickly turning cold tonight with a risk of frost in the north and east. However, clouding over in the west with rain and strengthening winds.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Tuesday, rain will move eastwards across all parts to be followed by scattered, blustery showers, heaviest in northwestern Britain. Becoming mostly dry in the east. On Wednesday, heavy rain will spread east across Wales and southern England with showers elsewhere.
