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REMARKS.

Monday

The barometrical pressures over our islands differ little from those on Saturday: yesterday they were lower every where - especially in the North. An increase has taken place since last evening in northern and western districts, but it has not extended to southern stations, where, however, the readings are now highest: a difference of nearly 7 tenths of an inch exists between those at Vairn and Rochefort.

Temperature yesterday was generally high: a considerable and general diminution has since occurred, amounting to 16° at Aberdeen.

Southerly winds were prevalent yesterday: they were strong on our southern and western coasts, and a gale was felt at Holyhead, which subsided during the night. Westerly winds of moderate force are generally reported this morning, but there are Calms at the Entrance of the Channel.

On southern and western coasts rain has fallen. In the N the sky is clear, but on other coasts it is cloudy, with fog and mist in the SW of England.

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REMARKS.

Tuesday

A sudden and very rapid diminution of barometrical pressure set in last evening in the N, amounting to more than half an inch in the last 12 hours. In Ireland and the S of England the decrease has not been so great, whilst on the W coast of France readings are nearly the same. Large differences now exist between pressures in Great Britain: the readings at Nairn and Penzance differ by 1.10 in. Readings in France are higher than those on the Channel coast.

Temperature has risen generally except at stations on the Channel coast.

A heavy Northwesterly gale set in yesterday at Ardrossan, which was felt at Leith with less force, and still continues at these stations. In the Irish sea the wind blew hard from SW at Holyhead, and is still continuing. Winds are strong from the westward in Ireland, but lighter in the Channel.

Heavy rain is reported from Ardrossan: the sea is very high there and at Valencia.

REMARKS.

Wednesday

The decrease of pressure reported yesterday has continued at all stations except in the extreme north, where there has been a slight recovery: the change amounts to 0.25 inch in the S. and S.E. of England. The difference between readings at Rochefort and Nairn has decreased, and is 1 inch this morning. The gradients along the West Coast have decreased very much, the change being 1 tenth of an inch per hundred miles between Valencia and Greencastle.

Temperature has risen a little in the S. and S.E.: elsewhere it has fallen - chiefly on the NE Coast.

In the Irish Sea and in the North Sea, as reported from our own station at Hamburg, a strong southwesterly gale prevailed yesterday, and a NW gale on the Irish Coast. The gale continues from the westward in Ireland, but in the Channel the wind has abated somewhat.

Rain has fallen in the N. and W. of our Islands, and in large amount in the NW of Ireland. The sea is very high at Valencia, and the weather is cloudy or overcast. Lightning is reported from Ardrossan.

REMARKS.

Thurs_{day}

Since last evening barometrical pressure has suddenly increased, especially in the NW: the rise at Ardrossan during the night has been 0.3 in. Readings are now more uniform than they have been for the previous 2 days, as pressure in France has decreased considerably: the difference between Nain and Rochefort is only half an inch.

Temperature is low in Scotland, and has fallen rapidly in the S. and SE. — at Yarmouth the change has been 14°.

The gale of yesterday prevailed chiefly on the Irish Coast and in the English Channel, and ceased during the night. This morning winds are, in general, northwesterly, and of moderate force: at Cape Clear a NE wind is reported.

Rain has been general, and at Greenacastle it has been very heavy. Snow and hail have fallen in the N: thunder and lightning are reported on the N and W Coasts.

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REMARKS.

The changes in barometrical readings since Saturday have been very rapid, the decrease amounting to nearly an inch. In the North and West pressure has begun to recover itself since yesterday, but, but readings at all stations are nearly uniformly low, the least reported being at Scarborough, while that at Rochefort is only 0.4 inch higher; there is accordingly not much wind this morning.

Temperature yesterday had increased very much on our E Coast: it has decreased today.

On Saturday night and during yesterday heavy southwesterly gales prevailed in these Islands and on the W. Coast of France: in the SW the gale continued last night, but this morning winds have veered on our Coasts, and are now from N to W and moderate on the Irish Coast and in the Channel. On the W. Coast of France the SW gale is still reported. Heavy rain has been general and the weather is cloudy.

A large and rapid increase in barometrical pressure has taken place on all Coasts except in the S. of France: the change has exceeded 0.4 inch at several of our stations, and the motion during the night has been greatest on our E Coast. Readings are remarkably uniform, the greatest difference reported being only 0.2 inch.

Temperature is much lower everywhere: at Naim the change has been 13°.

In these Islands the winds yesterday were generally moderate from the NW. A heavy S.E. gale prevailed in the Gulf of Lyons, where it still continues: at all other stations the winds are light and variable.

The weather is fine in places, but cloudy in the south, with fog on the Channel Coast. The gale in the S. of France has been accompanied by heavy rain.

REMARKS.

Mon-day

The uniform pressures of the last few days have undergone a change; and yesterday morning a considerable decrease had occurred at the western stations. In the SE there was a slight rise. The diminution has this morning become general and still more marked; and the lowest reading (at Cape Clear) is 0.9 in. below that at Helder. Pressure in the extreme south is not high.

Temperature yesterday was higher in the north and west but lower in the Centre of England than on the previous morning. Today it has increased generally and is high in the Southwest.

A southerly gale set in on the Irish Coast yesterday morning and has now extended eastward along the S of England and to Brest; but has subsided at Valencia with very little change in direction. Fresh southeasterly winds are generally prevalent elsewhere.

The weather is overcast this morning, with rain all along our S. coast. Very heavy rain has fallen in the S of Ireland. A high sea is running in the Channel and at Valencia.
