Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
A grey, misty start locally but it should become brighter with some  
sunshine developing, eastern parts most favoured. Scattered heavy,  
perhaps thundery showers, affecting parts of Wales and western  
England initially, will slowly transfer eastwards across the  
Midlands, reaching East Anglia later. Western districts are likely to  
see thicker cloud, along with the chance of some rain or drizzle in  
places. Very warm generally, and still locally hot in the brighter  
east.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:  
Mainly dry and bright on Friday but showers likely in the northwest,  
with perhaps some rain across southern parts. Wet, windy weather  
affecting western districts later on Saturday.
