

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Wednesday 04 May 2011

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
After an early frost, most will see sunshine, with a warmer feel than recently aided by light winds. Southwestern Britain will be cloudier however, with Northern Ireland seeing an increasing risk of rain. Milder overnight than of late, with cloud increasing from the west to bring rain into Northern Ireland and western Britain, with the east remaining predominantly dry.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

On Thursday, southern and eastern UK seeing sunny spells and a few well-scattered showers, whereas northern and western parts will be cloudier with occasional rain. This split continues on Friday, with an increasing chance of the odd rumble of thunder.
