

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Friday 28 Nov 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Cloud and rain, locally heavy, will persist today across southeast England and East Anglia, but will mostly clear away eastwards overnight. Elsewhere many places dry with initial patchy fog slowly clearing, away from western coasts where scattered showers will continue. The showers will be wintry across Scotland, high ground today but lower levels overnight across northern Scotland. Generally rather cold.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Saturday rain across far southeast England, wintry showers across northern Scotland. Elsewhere mainly dry, but with fog lingering in places. Sunday rain or sleet will extend north and westwards across England, while wintry showers affect northern Scotland and Northern Ireland.
