Headline:

Rain in places overnight, clearing southwards Thursday. Rather cloudy.

This Evening and Tonight:

Patchy fog/frost/ground frost in places, although outbreaks of rain over Central/southern Scotland/N.Ireland will spread southwards across parts of England and Wales.

Thursday:

Patchy rain/drizzle across the southern half of the UK will become showery before dying out. Rather cloudy, perhaps brighter in the west as well as SE Scotland.

Outlook for Friday:

Rather cloudy. Patchy rain in some central areas with showers further north. Windy in northeast with local gales.
