Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Hazy sunshine in places, but with sporadic rain or thunderstorms moving northwards, bringing some localised heavy downpours and local flooding. Southwest England, Wales and Northern Ireland will be generally grey and misty with patchy rain or drizzle with fog over hills and some coasts. It will be warm and humid across central and eastern areas, but will feel cooler in the west.  
Tonight, thundery rain will become more confined to northern and eastern areas, many central areas becoming dry. Western areas will have extensive low cloud with rain or drizzle at times. It will again feel sultry.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:  
Remaining unsettled with rain or showers, heaviest in the east where further thunder is likely. It will remain warm in the east, but cooler in the west.
