Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
A lot of cloud generally with showers or rain across much of Scotland and northwest England, Wales, southwest England and parts of Northern Ireland. The far southeast of England will also see some heavy showers for a time. Remaining areas should be much drier and brighter, the best of the sunshine over central southern England. Feeling a little chilly.

Rain or showers will continue overnight, mainly in western areas. Generally dry elsewhere with some fog and local frost patches.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:
Unsettled on Monday with showers or rain for many. Some rain in the north on Tuesday but many other places dry.
