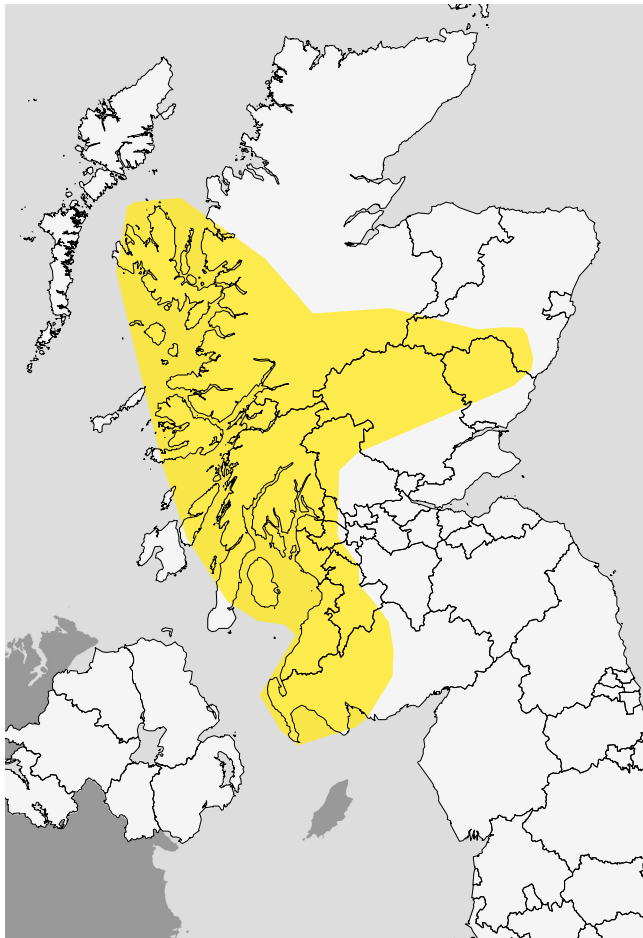


**Yellow warning

23:59 Wed 11 Nov 2020



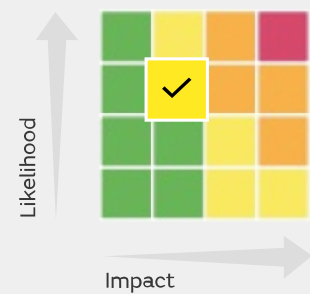
Heavy rain will persist throughout Wednesday, with some disruption due to surface water expected.

What to expect

- Spray and flooding on roads probably making journey times longer
- Bus and train services probably affected with journey times taking longer
- Flooding of a few homes and businesses is likely

Further details

A band of rain will push in from the west during the early hours of Wednesday, this will persist throughout the day with accumulations of 40-50 mm widely expected within the warning area. Potential for 70-80 mm in Dumfries and Galloway and across Skye. This will be accompanied by strong southerly winds.
