

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Cloudy with outbreaks of light rain over southeastern Britain for much of the day. Rain, sleet and hill snow over northeastern Scotland moving south across northern England and into Wales, weakening as it moves south and clearing any freezing fog patches. Further rain, hill snow, spreading into northwestern Scotland later. Cold.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Rain over Northern Ireland and western Scotland, with snow on Scottish mountains, at first spreading southeast on Tuesday morning and dying out. Showers over southwestern Britain. Further area of rain spreading east later on Tuesday and during Wednesday morning, with snow on hills on eastern edge of this band.
