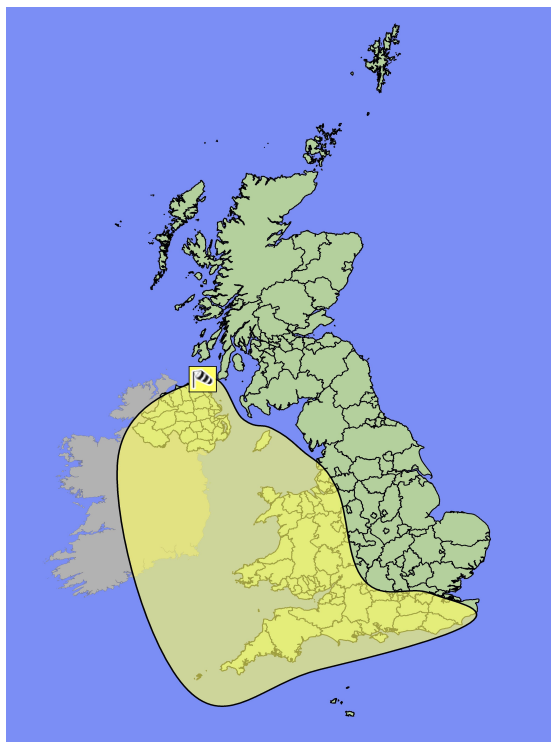




National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment

An active front will cross from west to east on Monday evening the potential for severe gales or storm force winds and 30-50 mm of rain over parts of southwest England and Wales. Computer models continue to give different forecasts, so there remains some uncertainty, though it is possible that this warning will be upgraded to amber.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Alert of Wind**

Valid from **18:00 on Mon, 12th Dec 2011** until **23:59 on Mon, 12th Dec 2011**

Strong winds on Monday evening have the potential to cause some disruption, especially in areas exposed to the south. In addition, rain will turn persistent and heavy bringing the risk of surface water flooding over southwest England and Wales. At this stage there is some uncertainty and the public are advised to monitor forecasts to keep up to date with this warning.
