

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Monday 05 Dec 2011

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Sunny intervals and wintry showers across northwestern areas, but snow becoming mainly confined to hills. Occasional rain showers across southwest England, but staying largely dry and bright elsewhere. Becoming clear across central and eastern Britain overnight, but wintry showers continuing across western areas, with a chance of more snow clipping northeast Scotland later. Icy patches forming in some western areas.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

After a locally icy start on Tuesday and Wednesday, further showers are likely. These will be mainly focussed across western areas and perhaps northern Scotland, perhaps falling as snow on northern hills. Staying mostly dry with sunny spells elsewhere. Cold.
