

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Dry for many but generally cloudier than yesterday, best of the brightness in central areas, the far southwest and northeast Scotland. Cold and dreary in the southeast, with patchy rain or drizzle. A band of rain will reach northwest Scotland this afternoon, and move southeastwards overnight, followed by clearer showery conditions.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

The cloud and patchy rain will continue southeastwards on Friday, clearing the southeast by evening. Colder, brighter conditions following, with scattered showers in the north and west, wintry over northern hills. Cold again Saturday, with windy, unsettled conditions in the north and west, generally drier and brighter further southeast.
