Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Cloudy with occasional light rain in Scotland, and also in Northern Ireland at first. Most of England and Wales should start brighter, with cloud expected to extend southwards into northern and eastern areas later, while southwestern parts keep some hazy sunshine throughout. Becoming generally clearer overnight, with cloud hanging on longest in eastern England.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

The settled weather will continue over the weekend: dry, warm and often sunny across the UK, although variable cloud may hide the sun at times, this most likely in the east. Winds increasing along the south coast by Sunday, otherwise light winds prevailing everywhere.
