Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Persistent rain across southeast Scotland and northeast England, will gradually ease through the day. Elsewhere, a mixture of sunny spells and scattered heavy showers, some of which will be thundery, especially in the east. Becoming drier and brighter from the west later. A cool northwesterly breeze.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Thursday will start chilly for the time of year, but largely fine with some morning sunshine for much of the UK. Rain spreading from the southwest as the day goes on. Heavy rain or showers in the south on Friday, as well as a band of heavy rain across northern England and southern Scotland.
