

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Southern England and south Wales sunny spells and mostly light showers.
Elsewhere largely cloudy, with showers or longer spells of rain. However,
southwest Scotland becoming dry later. Strong winds, especially eastern areas.
Feeling cold. Tonight many places becoming dry and clear with a slight frost, as
the wind decreases light. Some showers will persist around western and northern
Scottish coasts.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Friday scattered showers, some heavy, across Northern Ireland, the far north and
west of Scotland. Cloud and rain will spread across southwest England through
the afternoon. Otherwise dry with sunny spells. Saturday rain quickly clearing
east, then sunshine and showers.
