

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 1945 on Saturday 03 Aug 2013

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
A cloudier day, with outbreaks of rain spreading across western England, Wales, and into Southern Scotland, becoming heavy at times. However southeastern England will stay mostly dry with sunny spells, whilst isolated blustery showers will continue in the northwest. Whilst temperatures will remain around average for August, it will be feeling fresh in a moderate southwesterly breeze.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:
Overnight rain will clear eastwards on Monday, to leave most areas dry and bright. Although showers are again likely in the northwest. A mostly dry but cloudy day is expected on Tuesday, however further scattered and potentially heavy showers are likely later on.
