

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Outbreaks of rain, heavy in places, across southwest England, east Wales and perhaps the West Midlands through Thursday morning, although this easing as it moves into northwest England and eastern Scotland. East and west of this, mainly dry, with some sunny spells. Cloud, hill fog and occasional drizzle will become quite extensive overnight. Mild again, by day and night.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Northwest Scotland will see more sunshine on Friday. However, many other areas will be grey, and damp at times. Rain, accompanied by freshening southerly winds will affect many western areas by the afternoon. Brighter, but with a few showers on Saturday.
