

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Friday 08 Feb 2013

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Occasional outbreaks of rain, sleet and snow edging eastwards today. The snow generally over higher ground but perhaps falling to some lower-levels in the east at times. Drier and brighter periods are also likely, particularly in the west. Cold with a frost in places overnight, especially further east.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Some brightness at first tomorrow, especially in southeast Britain, but generally becoming cloudier with outbreaks of rain and snow spreading erratically east. There is a risk of more widespread outbreaks of rain and snow on Sunday, especially further north and east, where snow may fall to lower-levels at times. Feeling increasingly cold.
