Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:

A band of occasionally heavy rain across southern Scotland, northern England and Wales initially, will continue southeastwards through the day, clearing southeast England during the early evening. It will be a rather cloudy but mild start for areas ahead of the rain. Colder conditions following with sunshine and occasional showers, these wintry over northern hills. Breezy across most parts.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

A bright and frosty start for most on Saturday before becoming cloudy and windy with rain arriving across the north and west. Mild and remaining windy on Sunday with rain continuing in northern and western parts, drier and brighter elsewhere.
