

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Thursday 07 Oct 2010

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Dry with warm sunshine for most after any early fog lifts. Cloudier in Scotland, with a chance of a few showers. Becoming cloudy in southern England later in the afternoon, with some patchy rain possible. This moves northwards overnight to reach all parts of the country except northern Scotland by dawn, with clearer skies following in the south.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:  
Friday starts largely cloudy, with perhaps patchy rain in the northeast and heavier spells in the far southwest. Brightening up later for most, but the northeast likely remaining wet. Dry, warm and sunny for the majority on Saturday; cloudier towards the northeast.
