

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain and hill snow over northern England and Northern Ireland will continue southwards, becoming confined to Wales and southwest England by this evening. Clearer and colder conditions will follow, with snow showers and brisk winds for Scotland and northeast England. These will continue overnight, with a widespread frost elsewhere except southwest England and Wales which will remain cloudy and drizzly.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Remaining dry and cold for most throughout with some sunshine, but the far southwest will stay mostly cloudy. Wintry showers will continue across northern and eastern parts of the UK, but more persistent rain will spread into Scotland during Monday.
