

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Friday 21 Sep 2012

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Central England and Wales seeing outbreaks of rain this morning, the rain gradually moving southwards through the day. Some heavy bursts are likely, especially later on in the southeast. Further north, bright and chilly with scattered showers, heaviest towards the northeast. Overnight, rain clearing to leave most areas dry and clear, but becoming cold with fairly widespread frost.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

On Saturday, much of the UK fine and dry with plenty of sunshine and light winds. Temperatures somewhat below average after a cold start. On Sunday, many places still fine, but wet and windy weather spreading into southern Britain during the day.
