

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:

A mostly cloudy morning with outbreaks of rain spreading across Wales and the southern half of England while a few showers affect northern parts of the UK, although eastern Scotland and northeast England should stay dry. Wales and southwest England will become drier this afternoon, a few bright or sunny spells developing across some northern areas. Temperatures mostly near normal.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Very unsettled and becoming windy with spells of heavy rain spreading from the west across all areas on Sunday and again later on Monday. Gales in exposed northern and western areas especially later on Monday. Temperatures near or above normal.
