

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 1945 on Sunday 02 Jan 2011

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Outbreaks of rain, sleet and hill snow moving south across Scotland, reaching northern parts of Northern Ireland and northern England by nightfall. Rain and hill snow across the Southwest edging further east during the day and becoming confined to the south coast by evening. Otherwise dry with some sunny spells but staying cold.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:
Many parts of the UK rather unsettled, with outbreaks of rain and hill snow accompanied by brisk southwesterly winds. though southern England should stay mainly dry until Tuesday night. Clearer conditions with wintry showers following into northwestern areas on Wednesday, but staying generally rather cold.
