Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Another cold start, with widespread frost and icy surfaces across the UK, and with wintry showers in northwestern Scotland. Dry and sunny for many during the morning, but with cloud spreading from the northwest to most parts by evening, bringing rain to northern Scotland and patchy rain elsewhere in the northern and western UK overnight. Becoming less cold than recently.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Predominantly cloudy and dull for Friday, with rain across Scotland and northeastern England during the morning, becoming increasingly confined to the northwest of Scotland later. Cloudy and mainly dry for Saturday, with some brighter spells in east. Remaining somewhat milder.
