Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Rather cloudy across England and Wales at first, with some eastern parts hanging onto the cloud. Elsewhere, there will be sunny spells developing, with the best of the sunshine across Scotland and Northern Ireland. Rather cloudy with patchy rain affecting the Northern Isles. Mostly dry, clear and chilly overnight with frost possible in rural areas.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Dry with plenty of warm sunshine across England and Wales. Cloudy across northern Scotland with some patchy rain, but fine across the rest of Scotland and Northern Ireland. Starting dry and bright on Thursday. Gradually turning unsettled from the south with heavy and thundery showers.
