Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Low cloud and fog will affect much of England and Wales during the morning, locally dense and freezing, especially through central England. This will be slow to lift, persisting throughout the day in places. Southeast England will stay mostly cloudy and dull but, elsewhere, brighter skies are expected to develop, the best sunshine likely in the northeast. Generally cold.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:
Staying generally dry. Rather cloudy at times but bright or sunny intervals developing in many areas, even southeastern parts over the weekend. However, there will be an ongoing risk of low cloud and lingering fog with overnight frosts. Mostly rather cold.
