

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
A dry, sunny and warm day for much of England and Wales but cloud and outbreaks of rain will continue across much of Scotland and Northern Ireland. Rain will move very slowly southeastwards across England and Wales overnight, weakening and fragmenting to leave mostly dry but cloudy weather by dawn. Clearer and colder conditions will follow across Scotland.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

It will be largely dry and settled with sunny spells and light winds, although a few spots of rain are possible across southern England and the northwest of the UK. It will be mild by day but cold nights are likely.
