Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Showers over Northeast England will merge to give heavy, persistent rain this morning, and this will slowly migrate northwards into southern and eastern Scotland through today and tonight. Other parts of the UK will see sunny spells and locally heavy showers and some showers will continue overnight. There is also a chance of persistent rain in southern England this afternoon.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Persistent, heavy rain will continue over parts of Scotland on Sunday but should clear during Monday. Otherwise, it will remain unsettled with further showers for many, some of these heavy and thundery. It will turn cooler and breezier by Monday.
