Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It will be icy this morning across parts of northern, central and eastern
England and Northern Ireland. There will be a few more patches of rain, sleet
and snow in these areas at first, although these will tend to peter out to leave
a mainly dry afternoon. Most places will be cloudy and it will remain very cold.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

On Thursday any frost and patchy fog will gradually clear to leave a cold and
dry day with some sunshine breaking through in many areas. After a cold start
Friday looks set to be another dry day with sunny spells.
