Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
For much of England and Wales, it will be a rather grey, misty day with fog lingering in places and, although mainly dry, patchy rain or drizzle is expected. However, further northwest, Scotland, northern Ireland and the far north of England is expected to be brighter with some sunshine, although here, too, overnight freezing fog patches are likely to be slow to clear. Generally rather cold, locally cold in any lingering fog.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:  
Becoming unsettled across northern parts with rain and strong winds at times. The south, though, staying mainly dry, some bright spells. Temperatures recovering to near or above normal.
