Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Starting chilly in parts of southern UK, with early mist patches soon clearing to another dry, fine and warm day. It will be cooler, breezy and cloudier further north, with occasional rain towards the west that should ease overnight. Meanwhile southern UK should keep mostly clear skies, allowing mist or fog patches to develop later in the night.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

A warm, dry and fine weekend for many, especially towards the south and east. Cooler, breezier and more showery conditions in the northwest should gradually spread eastwards during Sunday, although the east of the country should stay fine until late on.
