Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Severe gales and heavy rain will affect the north-west from the start. The wet and windy weather will spread south-east across the country later in the day, but become less severe. It will clear south-east England during the evening, leaving a breezy, clear, dry night in the south. The north will stay windy with blustery and sometimes wintry showers.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:
Christmas Eve will be bright and breezy in most of England. Western Scotland, north-west England and Wales will have showers and strong winds, especially later. After a dry start in the east, Christmas day will become wet, mild and very windy.
