

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
A band of rain, which will be locally heavy, will move eastwards across the UK through the day, clearing all but the far southeast through the afternoon. Brighter, colder, showery conditions will then follow with some snow likely on the peaks of the Scottish Mountains. Remaining windy in the north.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
It will generally remain unsettled and windy with showers or longer spells of rain in the northwest of the UK. Elsewhere, it will be mainly drier and brighter with sunny spells for many. However, it will gradually turn wetter and windier from the west through the course of Monday.
