

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Sunny intervals and showers across Scotland today, some of them wintry.
Elsewhere, rain in northern England will move slowly southwards, fragmenting into showers as it goes. These should be mainly light but a few heavier ones are possible in Wales. Clearing skies for many areas overnight may give a touch of frost.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Most areas will see a mixture of sunny intervals and scattered showers on both days, with showers most frequent in Scotland on Tuesday, where they may once again be wintry. Staying cold, with winds becoming mainly light, and a continuing risk of frost in the north.
