

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:

A dry and bright start is expected for most, with a frost in places. However, rain and strong winds in the northwest will creep south into central parts through the day and southern parts by the end of the night. Rain may be heavier and more persistent in northern and western Scotland at times.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Mainly cloudy and breezy on Sunday, with outbreaks of drizzle. Brighter, colder weather will spread slowly south through the day and overnight. Some showers will develop, mainly around northern and eastern coasts, giving some snow over high ground on Monday. Widespread overnight frosts are expected.
