Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Further rain or showers for many parts today. Across Wales, much of  
England and, later, Northern Ireland, brighter spells are likely  
between downpours but, in southern Scotland and the far northeast of  
England, rain will persist, adding to the risk of local flooding. Fog  
lingering in northeastern parts. Warm in sunshine.  
Tonight, rain, heavy at times, nudging across Northern Ireland and  
northern England, but clearing from southern Scotland. Elsewhere,  
showers. Mist or fog in places.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:  
Further rain or showers, some heavy, across central parts on Friday  
but drier in the south. Saturday, many parts dry and fairly bright.
