

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
A drier day for most with sunny spells, lighter winds and scattered showers, most frequent and at times wintry in the north. Locally heavy rain then moves east across central/southern England and Wales through the afternoon and overnight. Becoming persistent with some wet snow, especially over the hills, clearing the west later. Clearer elsewhere with wintry showers in northwest.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Rain and snow clearing the southeast on Wednesday, leaving a colder, drier and brighter day for most. Windy for all with coastal gales. Showers in coastal areas, turning wintry over higher ground. Sunny spells on Thursday but cold with coastal showers.
