

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Thunderstorms and locally intense downpours of rain will continue moving northeastwards, with hail and gusty winds possible. Drier, brighter conditions following from the southwest. Staying humid in the southeast, and mostly fine in northwest Scotland at first. Scattered heavy showers continuing overnight in western areas. Elsewhere will be generally dry with clear spells and feeling fresher.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Drier, brighter on Sunday with sunny spells for many. There will be scattered showers, heavy at times, and possibly some patchy rain in southeastern areas. A risk of more persistent, perhaps thundery rain affecting southern and eastern parts Monday. Feeling warm in the sunshine.
