Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
Most places dry with plenty of sunshine, especially in the south,
after the clearance of any early mist. Northern Scotland cloudy with
light rain or drizzle, perhaps spreading to southeast Scotland and
northeast England later. Winds generally light. Warm, locally very
warm inland, but cooler near coasts due to sea breezes.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Early mist or fog soon clearing. A bright start for most each day,
but cloud building and showers developing inland, perhaps the odd
heavy one on Sunday, more isolated on Monday. More generally cloudy
over Scotland. Light winds, though coastal sea breezes. Warm or very
warm, cooler near coasts.
