Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Upslopes of western Scotland will continue to see rain and drizzle. Drizzle is likely at times in other western areas, but it will remain dry in the east. Cloudy in places to start, and areas of morning fog, but some brighter spells developing in the east.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

A band of rain will move south during Tuesday turning sleety as it clears. It will become colder with wintry showers to follow, falling as snow in western and northern highlands. Clear spells and showers for most parts on Wednesday, the showers becoming heavy in the west and north with hill snow.
