Headline:

Snow showers mainly in north and west. Otherwise dry. Frosty.

Snow showers over many northern and western parts. Mostly dry and clear elsewhere. Cold and frosty. Some icy roads likely.

Sunny spells with scattered snow showers, mainly in the north and west, also spreading across central England. Becoming drier over southwestern parts. Cold.

Outlook for Friday:

Mostly sunny spells and scattered snow showers. More cloud in south, possibly with some snow. Cold.
