Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Showers or longer spells of rain in the east today will be heavy in places. Brighter spells in many western parts but with a few showers likely over Wales and Northern Ireland where it will become more cloudy with patchy rain reaching the far west later. Temperatures near normal but feeling cool in moderate northwesterly winds. Tonight, cloudy with occasional light rain in the far west. Showery rain in the east will become mostly confined to eastern England by morning.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:  
Most places becoming dry with light winds and some bright or sunny spells.
