Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
A dry, bright start across many southern areas before thicker cloud and outbreaks of rain, already affecting parts of Northern Ireland, southern Scotland and northern England, move south during the day. However, the extreme south should remain dry. Southern Scotland will also be mainly dry with sunny spells, this brighter weather moving across Northern Ireland and northern England later, but northern Scotland will see frequent snow showers. Windy everywhere, making it feel increasingly chilly, with gales and local blizzards possible across parts of Scotland.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:  
Snow showers in northern areas. A lot of dry weather elsewhere. Windy and feeling cold.
