Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rather cloudy, although generally dry across England and Wales with just a little light rain in places and perhaps some bright spells. Scotland and Northern Ireland should see some sunshine. Rain will spread from the southwest across Wales and southern England by the evening, and persist overnight. A clearer, chilly night is expected further north.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Rain across England and Wales may turn heavy at times on Sunday, although may be lighter in the north and southwest. Scotland and Northern Ireland should remain brighter. On Monday rain should clear slowly southeast, with sunny spells and a few showers elsewhere.
