Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It will be mostly dry, sunny and cold for most. There will be a bitterly cold northeasterly wind in the south, but lighter winds elsewhere. Cloudier with rain affecting the Shetland Islands, where it will be windy, especially at first. It'll be another frosty night for many, but turning cloudier in the far south.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

After a frosty start on Monday, it will be mainly dry with sunny spells. Cloudy conditions in the south will spread northwards during the day, with some patchy drizzle. Cloudier for most on Tuesday, with some patchy drizzle at times. Feeling cold.
