Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Very strong winds and rain will blow across the country today, particularly north Wales, the Midlands, northern England and East Anglia. There will be lighter winds in Scotland, but significant snowfall in the southern Uplands and the central belt. The wind and rain will ease this evening, but there will be wintry showers in the north-west overnight and patchy ice.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:
Tomorrow will be dry and cooler for most with light winds and plenty of sunshine. There will be more rain and strong winds in Northern Ireland and western Scotland later. Saturday will become wet and windy again, especially the northwest.
