Headline:

Rain dying out, with sunny spells developing from the northeast.

Today:

A mostly cloudy and damp start then sunny spells will develop in most places, although it may stay cloudy over the south of England until dusk.

Tonight:

Most places dry with clear periods and a widespread frost, but becoming cloudy with outbreaks of rain across Northern Ireland and northwest Scotland.

Outlook for Friday:

Rain in the west and north. Patchy fog then sunny spells elsewhere.
